Pick-Up Broom Attachments

Pick-up brooms, on the other hand, work in a forward-facing position and offer additional containment for larger debris. With this attached bucket directly underneath the brush, you can push even bigger chunks of rock into it for better disposal down the line. As such, they're very popular for construction sites that have more difficult moving materials. Pick-up brooms are also a great option for road construction sites, docks, and warehouses or factories.

Making the Choice Between the Two

When it comes to determining whether the angle broom or pick-up broom is the best option for you, it's vital that you consider your desired application. They both have very different ideal use environments. As such, understanding what you want to use them for will be the key to making the most appropriate decision. Generally, pick-up brooms work for a broader range of job sites than angle broom attachments.
