Flow and Power Capabilities

You'll also want to think about your skid steer's flow rate and how that compares to the attachment's power capabilities. Some skid steer attachments have designated high or low hydraulic flow rates that affect the types of skid steers they're compatible with. As such, choosing incorrectly can impact the amount of power you have when cutting a yard. Skid Steer Operating Capacity
